Start the new year right. Join us to learn about practicing mindfulness and techniques to reduce stress from Sheila Griffin, instructor and project manager of the Calcagnini Center for Mindfulness at Jupiter Medical Center.

The center is 2,600-square-foot beautiful, soothing space overlooking the Jacqueline Fiske Healing Garden designed to provide assistance and teach people to be

more mindful, to cope with symptoms of stress, and to manage the tension of everyday life.

In addition to marketing and community relations responsibilities, Griffin teaches the mindfulness-based stress reduction (MBSR) program and other mindfulness programs at the center. She leads weekly yoga and meditation practices and coordinates the integrative medicine lecture series.

Griffin has practiced meditation and mindfulness for almost three decades, and was trained to teach MBSR by the University of Massachusetts Medical School, Center for Mindfulness. She has a bachelor of business degree from Loyola University in New Orleans and a master of public administration degree from Florida Atlantic University.
