Barbara McQuinn

McQuinn, who has been a school board member since 2016, will fill us in on the issues that Palm Beach County schools are facing today.

This is one of two Saturday morning meetings scheduled in response to a member survey last year.

McQuinn came to the board with more than 30 years of experience as an educator in the Palm Beach County School District. She began as an instructional aide in Riviera Beach, and went on to teach in Palm Beach Gardens and Allamanda elementary schools and Palm Beach Gardens High School, after earning a bachelor's degree in elementary education and a master's in mathematics education.

As a school administrator she recruited the first class into Suncoast High School as a magnet school, and later served as principal of Palm Beach Gardens High. She completed her career with the district as an area superintendent, supervising 33 schools.

She currently represents the school board in several community organizations and sits on the board's finance advisory and technical advisory committees. •
