<u>Donate to send girls to Tech</u> <u>Trek Florida STEM Camp</u>

Thank you to Mary Zivanov, Communications Coordinator for Florida Tech Trek, for providing the NPB branch an "inside, behind-the-scenes look" into the planning and execution of Tech Trek each summer. While the program itself takes place for a week in each of two Florida locations: FAU in Jupiter and Stetson in Deland, planning starts in early fall with extensive outreach to educators in Palm Beach County requesting that they nominate seventh grade girls who have an interest in pursuing STEM studies. Once nominated, girls must apply and participate in an interview process. At the same time, the team who runs the camp is busy putting together the curriculum for the week: core courses as well as more intensive workshops and evening programs, including Professional Women's Night. Each girl's participation in Tech Trek is 100% sponsored by AAUW so fundraising activities take place throughout the year to support as well. A highlight of Mary's session was hearing first hand from a Tech Trek 2023 alum who spoke about her participation and expressed her appreciation for having been afforded this valuable opportunity. Hearing her enthusiasm reinforces how important and how meaningful Tech Trek is.


